

# 4 Correspondence to the chair The chair confirmed there had been no correspondence.

5	Headteachers' Report
	The Headteacher informed governors that the school is still working towards academisation.
	The HT went on to remind governors about the changes around the governor meetings and that there would be six full governor meetings per year and encouraged all governors to attend. He then notified the governors of the three current governor vacancies, two parent and one foundation and that the school has recently signed into an SLA with shaping governance.
	The HT told governors that all performance management has been completed.
	There are three main targets the school is focusing on, which are the development of leadership, embedding formative assessment and Improving writing. There is also a big focus on the development of maths and behaviour for learning. The HT ran through the behaviour report and told governors that the school has been working with the HFCMAT on behaviour as well as attendance. The attendance has dropped since Christmas, which is currently at 93.6% and the attendance lead has joined an attendance triad, which consists of other schools within the MAT. A staff risk assessment has been completed, and any actions noted and implemented.
	The headteacher informed governors that there have been no data breaches and no safeguarding incidents. The pupil strategy has been reviewed and published, and all SEND information on the website is up to date.
	When the HT has compared the school's figures the FSM the school is currently at 39%, which is twice the amount of the national average, EHCP is 2.4%, which is in line with the

	national average, and SEND is also around the national average The headteacher explained to governors that the school webs to ensure that it is all up-to-date and accurate. 6	Quality of education
	The Headteacher informed governors that when looking at the quality of education 80% is good or better. There are measures put in place to support staff and the school is identifying target areas. The school is aiming for improving writing across the school and developing the curriculum ensuring all opportunities reach across the whole school.
	<ul> <li>Q- You said the quality of teaching needs improving in areas, and staff are being supported. Is there a timescale? Will the measures put in place allow the school enough time to get a good report if Ofsted visits?</li> <li>R- Ofsted will focus on the majority, they will ask what the school leadership is doing to support and that governors are aware of the support that is needed.</li> <li>Q- The support that is being put in place needs to be timely. How will this be done?</li> </ul>

#### 9 Diocesan Governors briefing

The Headteacher informed governors that he had sent out the diocesan briefing to governors. The Headteacher highlighted that the briefing included updates in regards to Ofsted

Q: There is some training coming up on religious education in the diocesan briefing. Is the school being represented?

*R:* We offered to be part of the trial period directory, but it doesn't come into force till 2025, The deputy head, as well as year one and year three staff, have been on training with dioceses. It is called the Vine and Branches, it is national and goes all the way through up until 18.

#### 10 Admissions

The Headteacher informed the governors that he would be speaking to the MAT to get advice on what admissions would look like.

11	HSE survey
	The HSE survey was not discussed.

12	P9 Budget report
	The headteacher informed governors that a meeting took place last week to review the P9 budget report. The report shows the school is expected to carry forward for the next two years; however, the budget will still need to be monitored closely. There is a reduction in pupil numbers which is reflected in the budget there are less than 30 in year three, and the expected pupil numbers for reception intake are no more than 30. The Headteacher informed the governors that he will meet with KD to look at what the school structure will look like next year.
